The Bellingham Theatre Guild's Play Selection Committee is seeking submissions from prospective directors for our upcoming 84th season. If you are interested in directing a full-length show during our 2012-2013 season, please complete the Play Submission Form and submit your selection(s) for consideration. The Committee will be reading all submissions in the coming months and welcomes newcomers and veterans alike.

Given the continuing economic climate we are looking for big-name productions that will draw in our audience. Shows that are well-known, well-loved, and that have not been done recently (within the last 5-7 years) are encouraged. If at all possible, shows that are outside of royalty rights (Wilde, Shaw, Shakespeare, etc.) will shave numbers off your budget and ours.

Please select up to a maximum of three shows you would be interested in directing and submit each on a **separate** Play Submission Form provided in this packet. **You will need to make a copy of the Play Submission Form for each proposal.** We do have a list of shows available that we believe could work well for both the Guild and its audience. Please let us know if you would be interested in receiving the list to look over and make selections from.

We will make final selections sometime in April. A list of Guild productions over the past 83 years is available for download at www.bellinghamtheatreguild.com. Please utilize the website to ascertain whether or not your submission has been performed within the last 5-7 years, as this will automatically make it ineligible for selection.
